PROGRAMS

- Create age appropriate awareness programs. Implement classes to spread awareness about self-love, abuse, and the trust circle. Educate the difference of what is acceptable or inappropriate with our "No touch zones" mentoring material.
- Establish a Safe House. The Safe house will provide temporary shelter, rehabilitation program and job placement assistance.
- Monthly mentoring classes for our youth and adults
- Quarterly empowerment seminars
- Conduct social experiments to bring awareness and impact lives.
- Connect with other organizations to offer our services and assistance.
- Create jobs that decrease abductions.
- Credited referral services and assistance
- One-on-one mentoring from our advocates via phone or live video.
